A Unique and Rigorous Learning Environment

The CTECS School District is very different from traditional high schools. We recommend students genuinely be interested in earning a technical education, learning a trade, and have a deep understanding of the rigor and demands of a CTECS education, including:

- A 182-day academic curriculum being taught in 91 days each year.
- The number of hours required to learn trade skills (both during school hours, after school, and sometimes beyond graduation).
- Requirements of earning credentials, certifications, and licensure for specific trades.

We recommend that you examine the CTECS website to understand some of the details of successfully earning a trade certification in conjunction with an academic high school diploma, which is offered to students who choose to attend a technical high school.

Application Timeline

- Complete the Electronic Application available on the website November 1, 2022.
- Priority Deadline: December 15, 2022
- Applications submitted after this deadline will only be reviewed if seats are available.



Application Timeline

- Mid-February 2023 Families are notified via email address given in application:
 - "Initial Notice" moving forward in application process
 - "Waitlist" only if seats are available, additional Initial Notices are sent.



Application Timeline (cont'd)

- February 2023 Families who received an Initial Notice must submit a "Parent Response" indicating desire to move forward.
- May 25, 2023 Henry Abbott Tech will hold a Freshmen Orientation event.



Application Process

- Only completed applications will be considered.
- Families must provide:
 - Contact Information (must be kept current)
 - "Student Interest Statement"-written by student.
 - School Counselor (if none, other school official) name and email address.



Application Process

- Sending schools must provide:
 - Recommendation Survey (link sent from CTECS)
 - All educational Records
 - Transition meetings (if required) by June 10.
